The Transformation of Adult Services



Adult Services are being transformed to offer more personalised services. Individuals now have more

control over the services they choose through personal budgets and direct payments.

Older people themselves are looking for new opportunities to remain active and mobile. They want to take part in activities that match their own personal interests.

More consumer choice creates an opportunity for Care Providers to respond with innovative new services that meet their clients' needs.

The ActiveCare Project

Travel plays a key role in keeping older and disabled people active by getting out and about. In many cases they can use free concessionary travel to stay active and keep in touch with friends and relatives.

The ActiveCare project works with Care Providers to show how travel can be used to develop uniquely personalised services to help keep older and disabled people active.

Types of Trips

The project features a growing contributed library of trips and activities

- **MyFavourite Visitors** for people who may be less mobile but are keen to receive inbound trips from friends and family
- **MyFavourite Places** featuring places that bring back special memories from the past
- **MyFavourite Trips** highlighting recommended trips that people have made either on their own or with their Care Provider



Each destination featured on the ActiveCare web site has a pre-built link to a journey planner. This means that anyone who wants to visit the same place only has to enter their own post code to plan their own free bus journey there.

By providing lots of examples of places to go the ActiveCare project aims to inspire other people to get out and about, contributing their own trips and adding their own reviews and ratings

Benefits to Care Providers

Trips are searchable by Care Provider so activity coordinators can use the ActiveCare web site as a way of promoting their own

services to both current and potential customers.
